ST PETERS RFC HEAD COACH 2018/19

Background:

Established in 1886 St Peters RFC is one of the oldest rugby clubs in Wales currently fielding 2 Senior Teams, a youth team and has one of the largest mini/junior sections in Wales which runs from U6 –U16. The 1st XV play in League 2 East Central and have finished in the top half of the table for the last 4 seasons. The 2nd XV play in the Cardiff & District Premier Division and the Youth in the Cardiff Blues 'A' league.

Facilities:

St Peters RFC owns its club house and has a long term lease in excess of 80 years on its 10 acres of grounds owned by Cardiff Council. We have 2 playing pitches and a training pitch which is floodlit. The clubhouse is situated adjacent to the pitches and boasts a large car park, 2 public bars, 4 changing rooms with showers and an outdoor patio area. There is also a physiotherapy room which can be used for treatment and rehabilitation of players during the week and also as a first aid room on match days.

Aims:

Our short term playing aims are:

- Our 1st XV to maintain its competitiveness in our current division and achieve a position in the top 5 by the end of the 2018/2019 season.
- Improvement of our 2nd XV to become more competitive within the Cardiff & District Premier League and used as a feeder for the 1st XV.
- Retention and recruitment of players to achieve our short term and long term aims.

Our long term playing aims are:

- To achieve promotion to League 1 East Central
- To be able to put out a 3rd XV.

Our off field aims are:

- To create a club with a sense of belonging where all members, supporters and players feel proud to be part of e.g. Younger players that have gone away to university returning after their studies .
- To improve the social aspect of the club with regular activities for its players and members.
- To organise a players rugby tour at the end of the 2018 /2019 season.

Vacant Position of Head Coach

Following our current coach's decision to step down at the end of this season we are now looking for a replacement with a good rugby background and at least a Level 2 coaching qualification but preferably Level 3, or someone working towards Level 3, or player coach.

The Head coach will be primarily responsible for the 1st XV working closely with the club captain and team manager but also required to liaise with the 2nd XV, Youth management team and club committee. The Head coach will be expected to be available for 2 training sessions a week (currently Tuesday and Thursday) and on match days.
